Rules Governing Public Comment at Meetings
(adapted from Jefferson County Rules)

Public comment will be limited to 3 minutes and will be strictly enforced.

Speakers (and guests) are allowed to speak only once (subject to above time limit) in the order they submitted letters asking to place a topic on the agenda. Letters must be postmarked 14 calendar days prior to board or resident meeting.

A topic will be addressed only once.

Letters requesting inclusion on the agenda must include:

Speaker's Name

Speaker's Address

Subject Matter

Any document, picture, or other evidence (to be retained by the Village)

Comments that require research will be tabled until the necessary research can be completed.
